Custom Disability Solutions Launches Secure File Transfer Application

South Portland, ME – November 1, 2007: Custom Disability Solutions (CDS) announced today that it has implemented a new web application that lets CDS employees exchange data, records and files with outside parties – clients, physicians, vendors and claimants – over an encrypted connection. The web application provides enhanced security for passing sensitive information, and allows for the exchange of files too large to send via e-mail – all without the need for either party to install any special software.

“Maintaining the privacy of client information and claimants’ personal and medical information is a priority for our organization,” said Jerry Bannach, President and CEO of CDS. “With the amount of data and files that pass through our organization, it was imperative that we implement a secure and easy way to transfer files between CDS employees and outside parties. This solution enhances our security, and helps to strengthen our clients’ and claimants’ trust in CDS.”

CDS’ new Secure File Transfer application uses ‘bank level’ security and encryption to protect information when it is transferred between parties. The application provides users access to a password-protected Extranet. Once they’ve logged in, the Extranet allows users to send files to CDS, and to download files they have received. These files can be up to 10 times larger than what most companies’ email servers will handle.
